ADDITIONAL SERVICES

The following services are not covered by the FBAS scheme, but can be provided on a time charge basis:

- Review current livestock enterprise gross margins alongside a forage-based system to quantify potential productivity benefits against infrastructure costs.
- Identify Key Performance Indicators to help re-focus livestock strategy.
- Create and monitor a feed budget focussed around pasture plants and making the most of pasturebased nutrition.
